GENERAL CAMP INFORMATION

DRESS CODE

We expect all students to wear nice school attire for all the sessions; students should come to the first orientation session in school attire as well. The boys should wear slacks (not jeans) and shirts with collars, and the girls should wear skirts and blouses or dresses. During the free time in the afternoon, students may wear casual clothes as follows: **boys:** blue jeans and sweatshirts or shirts without collars; **girls:** loose-fitting, knee-length garments, or loose fitting slacks. Please have your students prepared in advance so that they will know what is expected. We will be having some free-time activities outside, so the students will need to bring a change of clothing for this.

WHAT TO BRING

Students and sponsors will need to bring linens, pillow, and/or a sleeping bag. Bedding is not provided by the camp. Students and sponsors will also need to bring towels, washcloths, and toiletries for four days. Each student will need his/her Bible and a pen.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Room lists and the daily schedule will be given during the camp registration time. The included conference schedule will be subject to change. Conference booklets and handouts will also be given at the registration time. Plan to arrive at the conference between 2 and 4 pm on Monday.
